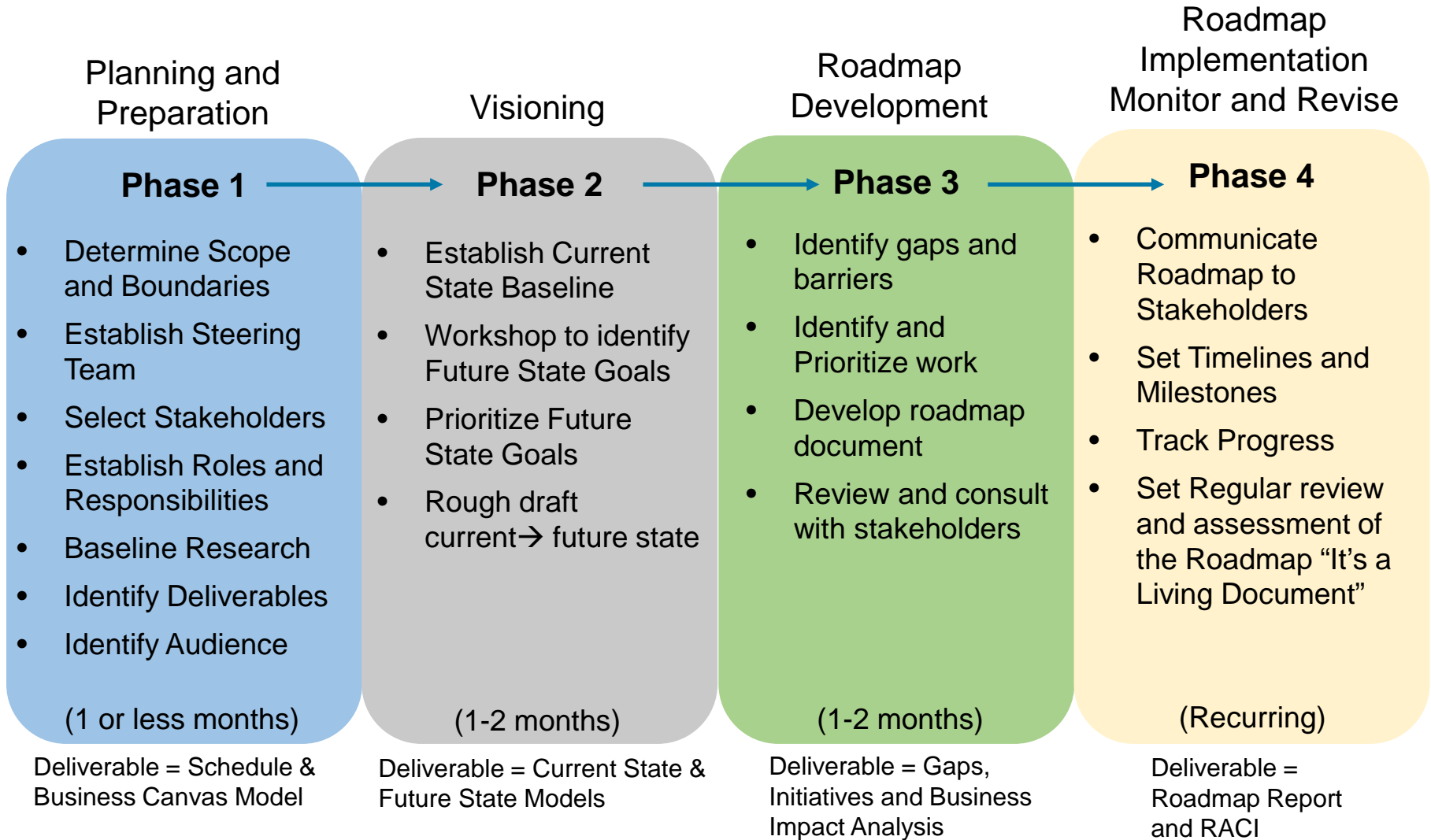

Roadmap Objectives

“Why we do this?”

1. Document and understand current state
2. Set future state goals, “**Where are we going?**”
3. Identify “**new**” desired capabilities to work towards
4. Improve and grow current capabilities
5. Establish clear roles and responsibilities
6. Justify, prioritize and align investments with business
7. Provide focus on what is important
8. Communicate and align business units in the same direction

2. Visioning Workshop

- Future desired state goals - “Where are we going?”

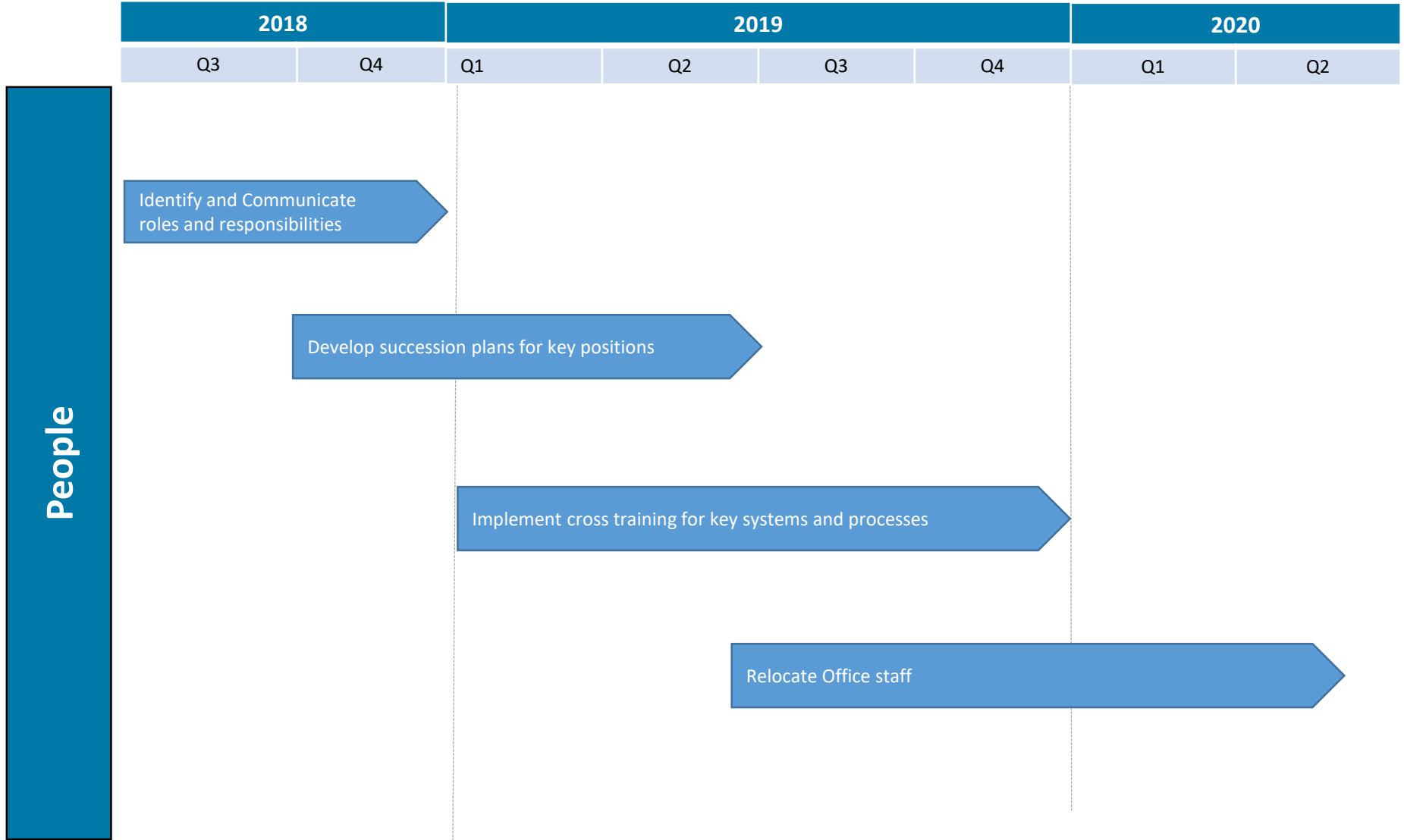
3. Gap Analysis and Initiatives

4. Roadmap Document

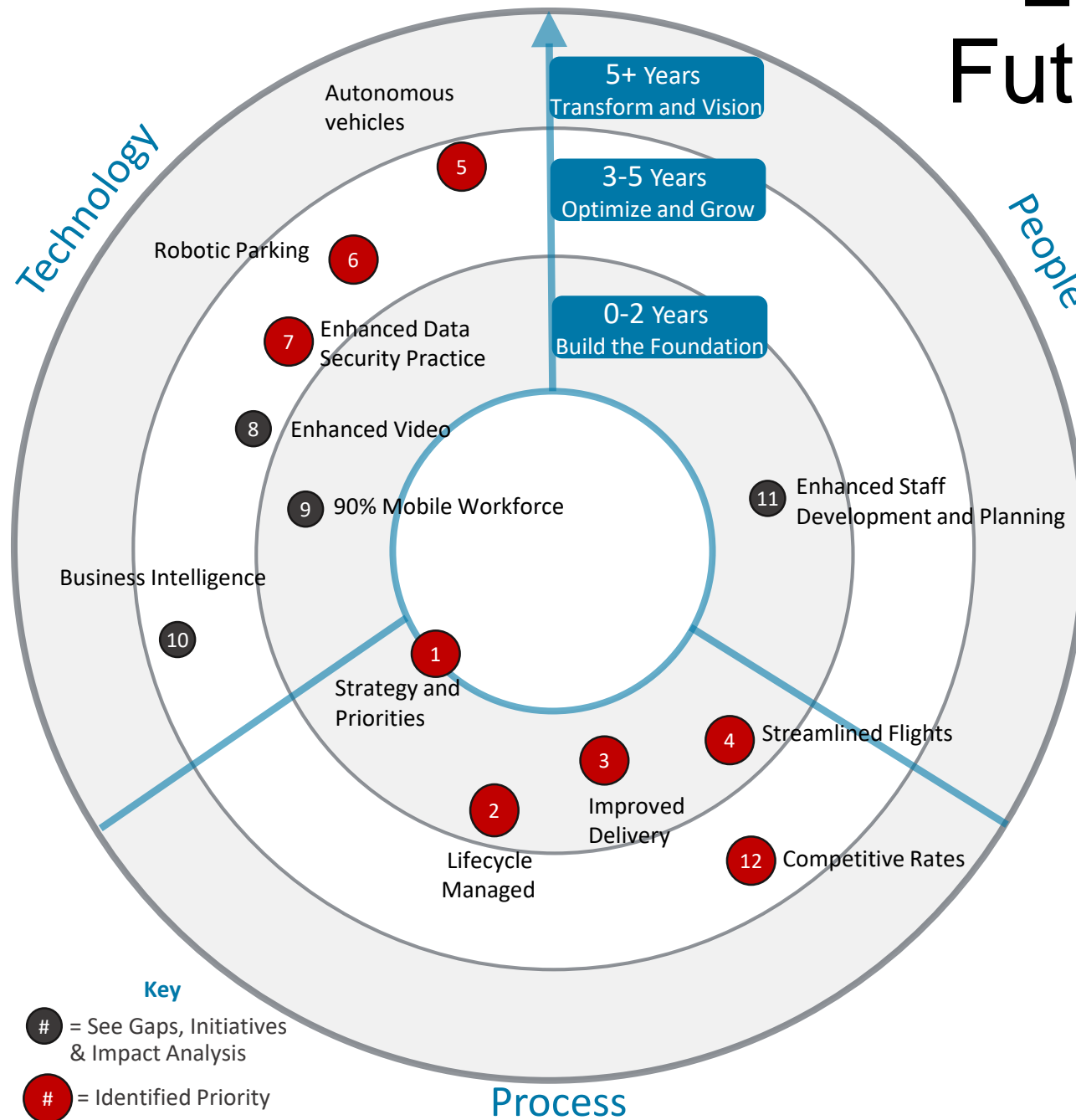
5. Communications and Presentations

Example 2 Year Roadmap Initiatives - People

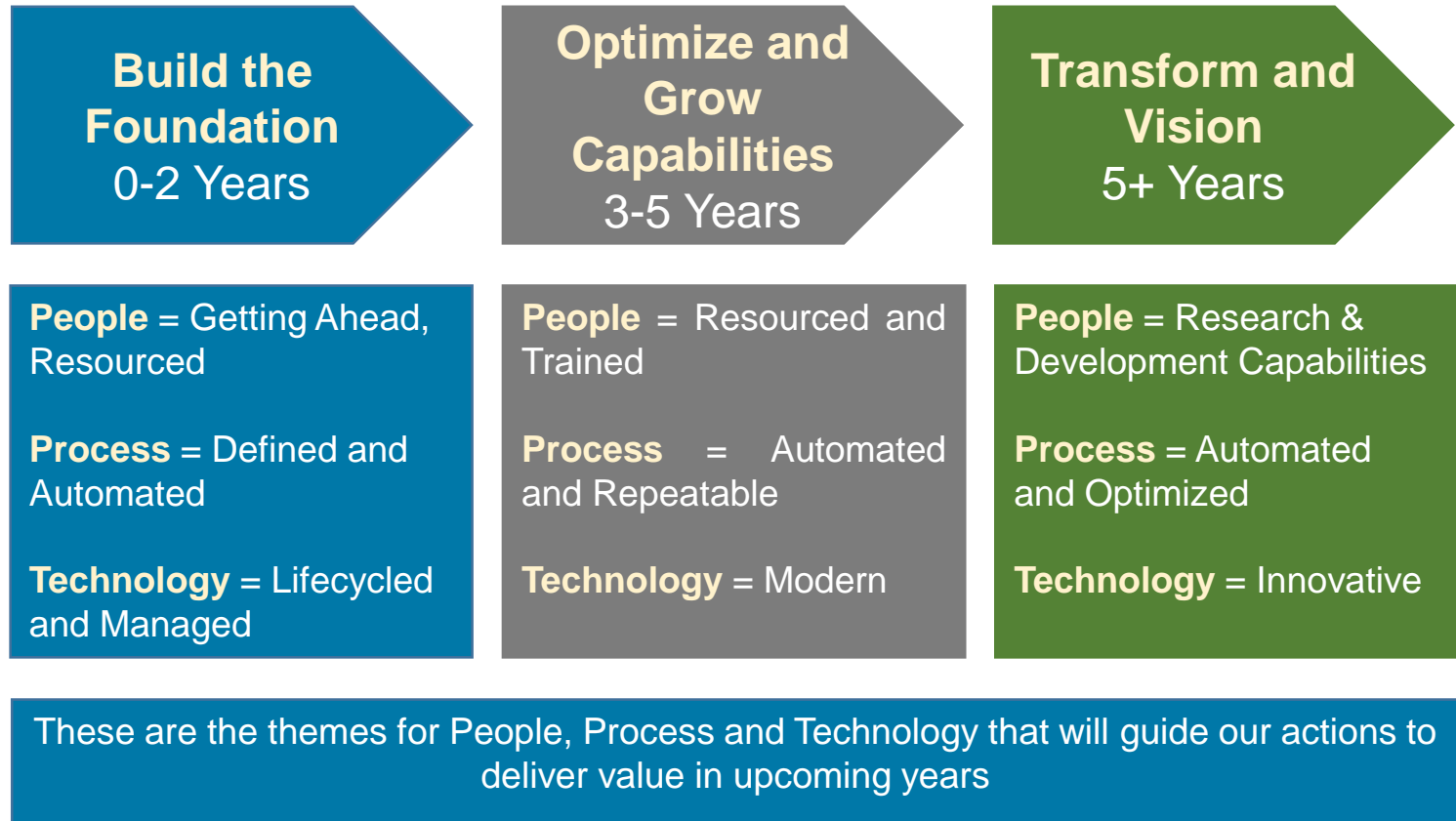


Key: # = Refer to Gaps, Initiatives & Impact Analysis for Details # in Roadmap Report ● = Identified Priority
